



Screening Criteria for Suspected COVID-19 Cases

- ① Within 14 days before the onset of the disease, the patient has a travel or residence history in the high-risk regions or countries;
- ② Within 14 days before the onset of the disease, the patient has a history of contact with those infected with SARS-CoV-2 (those with a positive NAT result);
- ③ Within 14 days before the onset of the disease, the patient had direct contact with patients with fever or respiratory symptoms in high-risk regions or countries;
- ④ Disease clustering (2 or more cases with fever and/or respiratory symptoms occur at such places as homes, offices, school classrooms, etc. within 2 weeks).
